RESOLUTION TO OPPOSE IMPOSITION OF AGENDA 21

WHEREAS, Agenda 21 is in diametric opposition to the principles of freedom and liberty for which American soldiers have fought and died in our lifetime; and

WHEREAS, Agenda 21 is violative of God-given rights protected by the constitution for the State of Minnesota as well as the constitution for the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, the true motive of Agenda 21 is hidden under the more palatable label of “sustainable development”, promoting relocating people from rural areas to cities, higher gas prices, manipulation of transportation patterns, forbidding human access to lands, seizure of private property, restricting amount of private water use, additional taxing, restricting the amount of waste, forced community involvement, for starters; and

WHEREAS, At risk from Agenda 21 are 1) private property ownership, 2) single-family homes, 3) private vehicle ownership and individual travel choices, and 4) privately owned farms;

NOW, WHEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that elected officials of Orrock Township join the list of cities and towns, and even the State of Alabama who now oppose this assault on American freedoms;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is the official policy of Orrock Township to oppose this assault on American liberties and freedoms for which our forefathers have given their lives;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that no policy promoted, mandated or suggested by the International Council of Local Environmental Initiatives (ICLEI) be imposed upon any citizen of Orrock Township or upon their lands.

Some history of Agenda 21:

Agenda 21 is a two-decade old, grand plan for global 'Sustainable Development,' brought to America from the United Nations. George H.W. Bush (and 177 other world leaders) agreed to it back in 1992, and in 1995, Bill Clinton signed Executive Order #12858, creating a Presidential Council on 'Sustainable Development.' This effectively pushed the UN plan into America's large, churning government machine without the need for any review or discussion by Congress or the American people.

The seeds for Agenda 21 were planted back in 1987 when the writings of [Gro Harlem Brundtland](#) (a woman who was [first Vice-President of the Socialist International](#)) caught the eye of the UN.
